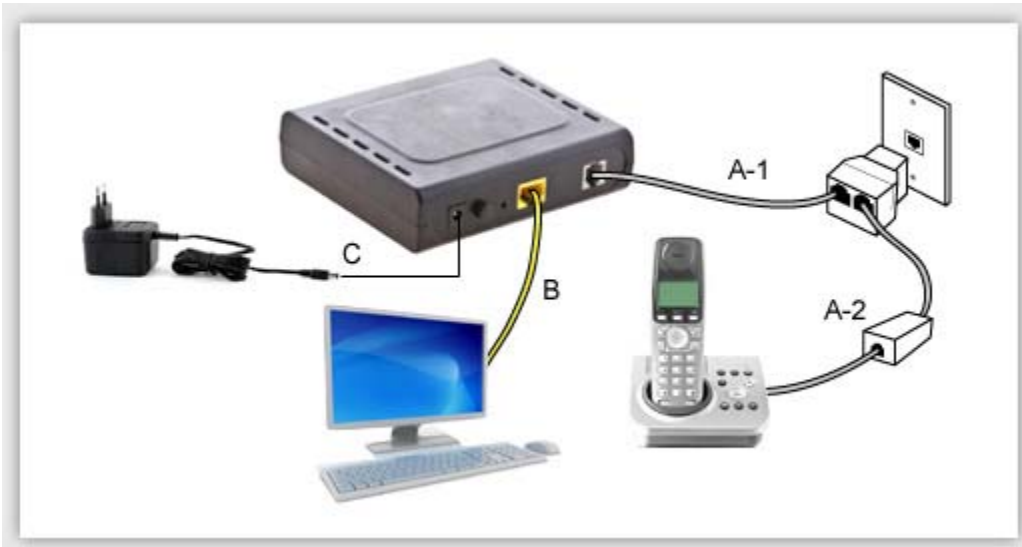


To install your own DSL modem:

Connect Your DSL modem

Refer to your modem user guide or follow the below steps:

1. Install DSL filters on all telephony devices in your home. (This includes phones, fax machines, satellite receivers and security systems.)
2. Connect the power supply to the DSL modem and plug it in.
3. Connect the phone cord to the DSL modem and plug into the phone wall jack. (There should be no surge suppressors or DSL filters on this line.)
4. Connect the network cable to the DSL modem and then into the Ethernet port on your computer.
5. Turn the power on and wait for approximately one minute.
6. The DSL/ADSL/SYNC light should now be solid on.

Setup Your Internet Connection

Before setup your Internet Connection, it is recommended you have the modem user guide on hand and well known about your modem setting page.

 - VPI: **0**
 - VCI: **35**
 - MTU: **1442**

3. Re-boot your modem and computer, wait until the internet light on, then go surf.
